PREFACE AND ACKNOWLEDGEMENTS

The 2008 Fire Code was the first comprehensive revision of New York City’s fire safety laws in almost a century and the first to be based on a model code. The local law enacting the 2008 Fire Code required the Fire Department to review future editions of the International Fire Code and propose amendments to the New York City Fire Code reflecting the latest fire safety standards and technologies, with appropriate modifications to address local conditions and concerns.

The 2022 Fire Code, the second code revision since 2008, again demonstrates the benefits of an ongoing national discussion, through the model codes, of fire safety standards. The 2022 Fire Code responds to the development of new battery technologies and the fire safety challenges they present, by establishing a regulatory framework for stationary energy storage systems appropriate for the New York City environment. The 2022 Fire Code also responds to the challenges of firefighting in high-rise megastructures, the very tall buildings that increasingly frame the New York City skyline. These and the many other fire safety enhancements in this edition of the New York City Fire Code serve to promote public safety, fire safety awareness, firefighting operations and firefighter safety, while remaining committed to practical solutions, and sensitive to the burdens of compliance. The 2022 Fire Code clarifies, simplifies and even eliminates requirements, and coordinates its requirements with construction code and zoning provisions.

The Fire Code revision process was undertaken with the participation of Fire Department fire officers, engineers, inspectors, and the attorneys and staff of the Code Development Unit; staff of the Department of Buildings, Mayor’s Office and City University of New York; City Council members and staff; and representatives of building management, design/engineering, manufacturing, public utility, real estate, and trade and union organizations.

The Fire Department thanks all of the individuals, agencies and organizations who participated in the Fire Code revision process and made enactment of the 2022 Fire Code possible.

CITATION

The New York City Fire Code is codified as Chapter 2 of Title 29 of the Administrative Code of the City of New York. Individual Fire Code sections should be identified using the prefix FC, e.g., “FC 101.1,” and may be officially cited as “29 NYC Admin Code §FC ____.”

EFFECTIVE DATE OF LOCAL LAWS

The 2022 Fire Code took effect on April 15, 2022, except for FC 511.7, which takes effect one year from the date of adoption of a zoning amendment exempting from the calculation of the building floor area ratio storage spaces in high-rise megastructures for pre-positioned Fire Department equipment.

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
