The *Minnesota Accessibility Code* includes Chapter 11 of the 2018 *International Building Code*® (IBC®), Section 305 of the 2018 *International Existing Building Code*® (IEBC®), and ICC/ANSI A117.1—2009 *Accessible and Usable Buildings and Facilities*. These documents are amended for use in Minnesota and the code book includes code language that is modified by Minnesota amendment.

IBC Chapter 11 and IEBC Section 305 provide detailed scoping requirements and ICC/ANSI A117.1—2009 provides detailed technical provisions. Additional guidance and definitions for the application of Chapter 11 and Section 305 can be found in the 2020 *Minnesota Building Code* and 2020 *Minnesota Conservation Code for Existing Buildings*.
